

GREATER GRAND RAPIDS USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Greater Grand Rapids USBC Bowling association will be awarding up to two (2) scholarships of \$1,500 along with up to two (2) \$500 scholarships this season. The scholarships will be awarded to the best candidates as determined by the Scholarship Committee.

ELIGIBILITY RULES:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior.
- 2. Must be attending or planning to attend an institution of higher learning.
- 3. Must be a USBC Youth Certified bowler for the present season with unimpaired amateur standing in the Grand Rapids Association.
- 4. Applications and attachments must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2022.
- Scholarship must be used by the recipient's 24th birthday or the money may be forfeited and returned to the association scholarship fund.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: (Check as you complete)

- 1. Return your completed application forms and *handwritten* essay to the Scholarship Committee.
- Have your school official or counselor send a transcript of your <u>last seven (7) semesters</u> of school to the Scholarship Committee. (Supply them with a stamped, addressed envelope.)
 - a. <u>High School Seniors</u> All available transcripts from 9th grade present.
 - College Students Your most recent transcripts which will include your college grades and high school grades.
- You may have more than one personal reference and they may include include teacher, counselor, employer, or minister, etc. They may not include your relatives.
- 4. Contact all of your references and make sure <u>all</u> your papers have been mailed before the <u>April 15, 2022</u> deadline. ANY DOCUMENTS RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

JUDGING:

Judging will be based on the following areas by the Scholarship Committee. The areas to be considered are:

- A. Bowling contributions and involvement
- B. Scholastic accomplishment
- C. Outside activities
- D. <u>Handwritten essay</u> personal, future plans/goals
- E. References

Final selection is at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

PRESENTATION OF AWARD:

All winners and their families will be the guests of the Greater Grand Rapids USBC Youth Awards Banquet to be held in June 2021. If you are a recipient, you will be notified with a telephone call and an invitation via the US Postal Service.

DISBURSEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

The scholarship will be sent to the accredited institution of the individual's choice upon receipt of acceptance by the institution. The Grand Rapids USBC Manager must be notified within 30 days and the money will be sent directly to the school. At no time will the money be given to the recipient or their parent(s).


