Judging will be based on the following areas and verified by a panel of judges and the family.

- A. Bowling contributions
- B. Scholastics
- C. Outside Activities
- D. Essay
- E. References

The scholarship winners will be notified by mail with an invitation to the USBC Youth awards banquet in June 2020.

Request for scholarship money must be requested 30 days prior to the students need and the money will be sent to the accredited institution of choice in joint name with the student. "At no time can the money be given to the student or their parent(s)".
